

Camp Pearl Safety and Usage Policy

In order to use the facilities at Camp Pearl for any event, you must agree to submit to the following policies. If policies are broken, we reserve the right cancel future contracts you may have with us and end any active rentals without reimbursement of any fees paid. We also allow you to do a walk through with one of our staff prior to your rental dates. This walk through will allow you to ask any questions about our facilities, note any damages that currently exist to our facilities, and be shown how to use any of our technical equipment.

Conduct and Doctrine

As a Christian camp, we expect all who use our facilities to submit to Christian conduct and character while on campus. An example of such character can be found in Ephesians 4:25-5:21. In order to hold a religious service of any kind on campus, you must agree to submit to our doctrinal statement which can be found on our website at camppearl.com/about-camp-pearl/

Camp Rules

No smoking inside buildings.

Park in designated areas only.

Do not drive any vehicles across the main grounds of campus, except for those unloading materials in canteen or cabins.

Do not drive cars, trucks, SUV's or other similar vehicles on walkways in front of cafeteria or chapel.

Prioritize driving ATV's UTV's and golf carts on roads unless necessary to load and unload people or materials.

ATV's, UTV's and golf carts can be driven on walkways up to chapel, cafeteria and gym.

Do not remove any fencing or blockades that we have set up.

No illegal activities.

All furniture must remain in the building it is currently in unless given permission to move it.

Tables and chairs in storage can always be moved as needed.

Any furniture that is moved or rearranged must be returned to the place it was found.

All installed equipment, such as sound or lighting systems, are intended to be used as they are installed.

Do not alter the wiring on the back of the sound board, the light system or the amplifiers. You are permitted to plug additional devices such as computers, stage monitors, etc. into the installed equipment.

Liability

If there are any damages due to negligence, non-intended use or break of policies, you are responsible for the cost of restoration beyond the initial damage deposit.

Exclusive Use

Exclusive use is defined as "no external group will be allowed to access the facilities and grounds during your contract dates except for Camp Pearl's staff." Camp Pearl's staff will only access grounds and facilities for work necessary for your retreat, including but not limited to cooking, cleaning, taking trash out, stocking bathrooms, visual facilities inspections, and performing maintenance requested by your group. If exclusive use is granted, your group will have exclusive access to all grounds and buildings. Houses to the east of the main road, office, as well as all roadways, are not included in exclusive use.

If your group includes 75 or more participants, we will grant you exclusive use. If we have multiple smaller groups that can share the facilities, we will coordinate with your groups to set

up a rotational schedule for use of chapel, gym, and outdoor recreation areas. If you wish to guarantee exclusivity, you are able to either pay for at least 75 participants, or pay a \$500 fee.

Abuse and Sexual Misconduct

In order to use our facilities, if minors are present, you must develop and practice an abuse and sexual misconduct policy intended to prevent any misconduct from happening. Your policy must be at least in accordance with your liability insurance company's recommendations. This policy must be submitted to us at least two weeks prior to your rental dates.
